
Therefore, the National Institute of Immigration has a presence throughout the state of Baja California for the provision of institutional services:

- ✓ 2 Migratory Stays (1 under review)
- ✓ 2 Human Repatriation Offices
- ✓ 3 Migrant protection locations (Beta groups)







POINTS OF ENTRY TO THE COUNTRY



The immigration officer is entitled to request various conditions for entry, such as proving his identity, reason for travel, place of habitual residence or provenance, address and length of stay in the national territory.



The procedure at these check points in order to authorize the internment of foreigners, consists of the interview of the immigration authority as well as the review of the documents.



A project was presented to the Director of the Tijuana International Airport, requesting a remodeling work, in order to condition the space of the aforementioned filter, derived from this, a waiting room was enabled, which therefore, will provide greater privacy and comfort to foreigners, during their stay in our space for second inspection.



E-GATES




- ✓ We have been working with the airport staff on the project of installation of e-gates



Baja California has 2 reception points for nationals, located in: «El Chaparral» In Tijuana, and «Mexicali Garita Uno»

Its objective is to achieve the reintegration of the repatriated Mexican population, through coordination with the three levels of government, civil society and private initiative, attending to their return in a safe and orderly manner.



LIAISON AND COORDINATION

There are several functions carried out here, and to this purpose, mechanisms are established for liaison and coordination with public, social and private institutions for the development of the actions of the program in order to ensure that the entry of repatriated nationals is carried out with absolute guarantee of their rights and are referred to the competent organisms.

They aim to provide humanitarian aid, first aid, migration assistance, guidance and information to migrants and are strategically located in areas of the state where they can develop their functions.





ORIENTATION TO MIGRANTS

They are dedicated to safeguarding the human rights of migrants who transit through the national territory, regardless of their nationality or migratory status.


They inform of the risks the migrants may face during their trip as well as the rights they have in Mexico to prevent abuses against them.





U.S. ALIENS WITH ARREST WARRANTS



Referring to foreigners housed in the immigration centers of this Representation Office who had arrest warrants in the United States of America; there is a register of **115** foreigners during the period of January – September 2023.


A FINAL COMMENT
