What is the Western Legislative Academy?

The West's premier training event for lawmakers in their first 4 years of cumulative service.

Three and a half-days of intensive skill building for state legislators from Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah, Washington and Wyoming.

What are the goals?

- Help legislators become more effective leaders
- Build strong state legislative institutions
- Foster collaborative networks between states

What will I learn?

- Strategies for influencing + collaboration
- Effective negotiation and conflict management
- Impacts of communication styles on the process of lawmaking
- · Navigating the transition from campaign to governance

What is the value?

- The WLA equips legislators with tangible tools to bring back to their chambers and fosters a support network of dedicated public servants to lean on during your career
- The Academy provides an environment for intentional reflection to grow as legislative leaders in an era of increasing demands on lawmakers' time.
- Since 2000, we have graduated 831 alumni who have returned to their state legislatures ready to make a difference.

Where is the Western Legislative Academy held?

- Commitment to the institution of the legislature
- Interest in improving the legislative process

Reminders about the Western Legislative Academy:

Because of the nature of the program and the importance of interaction among legislators, **participants must commit to attend the program in its entirety**. The WLA is a classroom experience, not a conference.

- Please keep a copy of your completed application for your files.
- You will be notified that your application has been received and if any information is missing.
- CSG West's bipartisan leadership will select WLA participants. Applicants will be notified in August regarding their status.
- Class size is 52, with at least two and no more than five per Western state.
- Selection is limited to legislators in their first 4 years of cumulative legislative service.
- Attendance at all WLA events is limited to Academy participants, CSG West staff, presenters and sponsors. There are no events for spouses, guests or children.
